Kumiko and the Dragon's Secret continues the fantasy adventure of Kumiko, a young Japanese girl who is guarded by the dragon, Tomodo.

In this sequel to the beautifully written *Kumiko and the Dragon*, danger surrounds Kumiko's family. The sinister shadow catchers have kidnapped Kumiko's sister, Arisu, seeking to absorb the dragons' magical powers through the royal human bloodline of Kumiko's family.

Kumiko is the only one who can defeat the shadow catchers. She alone has the power to rescue her little sister and restore order to the magical world of the dragons. But can she do it in time?

BRIONY STEWART grew up in Perth, peeping over alleyway fences in search of great mysteries and honing her excellent tree-climbing abilities. Her first book, *Kumiko and the Dragon*, won the Aurealis Award for Children's Short Fiction and was a 2008 CBCA Notable Book. Briony lives in Perth with her partner Harry, and their beloved pet rabbit Winston, writing and illustrating for children.

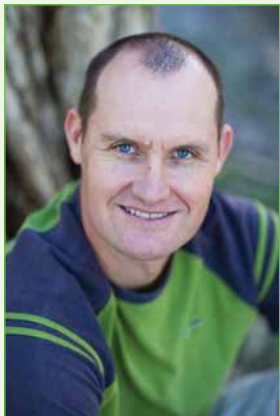

A companion novel to *The Tuckshop Kid* and *The Toilet Kid*, *The Tennis Kid* will have you laughing and crying, sometimes at the same time. It's about dealing with the biggest challenge of all – the pressures we put on ourselves.

PAT FLYNN grew up on an old dairy farm in Queensland before moving to the AIS for three years to play and coach on the professional tennis circuit. He now lives on the Sunshine Coast, surfs, writes and plays the occasional tennis tournament in his spare time. *The Tuckshop Kid* was a CBCA Honour Book for Younger Readers in 2007.

TOM JELLETT was born in Sydney and lived in Brisbane before his family moved to Adelaide. Since graduating from the University of South Australia in 1995 with a Bachelor of Design (Illustration) he has worked as a freelance illustrator. He also illustrated *The Tuckshop Kid* and *The Toilet Kid*.
